## Introduction

In 2008 the CEEC sought to promote and foster an environment for graduate research into the application of Construction Economic related topics within the EU.

A means of encouraging such research was to create the CEEC Graduate Education Project (CEGP) and its CEEC Graduate Education Award (CEGA), in which the best three assessed research papers are invited to the next General Assembly meeting of the CEEC to make formal presentations of their work.

The winner and runners up will receive awards and accreditation from not only the CEEC but their respective member Institutes. The three papers would also be published on the CEEC website.



## Aims

1. To provide a forum for international research into the development and application of Construction Economics across international markets.
2. To foster 'inter-third level' educational liaisons across the EU, in the standardisation, development and betterment of Construction Economics education.
3. To establish a valuable library of research papers accredited by International Construction Economic Institutes within the EU.
4. To pass on the benefits of international contacts made over the years by the CEEC. These contacts include universities and consultants within each of the institute membership, thus enabling introductions for both under and post graduate researchers who wish to incorporate data from these international sources.
5. To maintain fresh new members and contributors thus providing the CEEC with a continual source of new ideas to explore and review.
