



CEEC Education Graduate Award 2010/11

Details of Project

1. **Title of competition:** CEEC Education Graduate Award 2010/11 (CEGA 2010/11).
2. **What is required:** Paper should compare construction economic topics in at least two different European countries.
3. **Author:** to be single person only.
4. **Status of author:** undergraduate and post graduate students.
5. **CEEC marking criteria:**
 - a) Presentation: graphics, referencing, paragraphing, illustrations, flowcharts, appendices.
 - b) Content: body of work, logical flow of information, applicability of appendices, cross-referencing.
 - c) Research: demonstration of depth and breath of research, proper referencing, substantiation of findings through varied primary sources.
 - d) Conclusion: to demonstrate achievement of listed aims & objectives of research.
6. **How many words?**
 - a) Abstract: 150 to 300 words (based on CEGA paper guidelines).
 - b) Paper: up to 6 pages (based on CEGA paper guidelines).
7. **Language:** English.
8. **Rules and criteria:** will be issued on receipt of application form.
9. **Submission:** by submission of a paper the author will give permission at no charge to the CEEC or its members to publish the contents or part contents of their paper. Authors are to ensure that they receive and provide permissions to publish or quote data where same is required.
10. **Submission of applications, abstracts and papers:** only via email to cega@ceecorg.eu; you will receive a confirmation of receipt via email within the next 24 h.
11. **Independent adjudication:** by professors and lecturers in construction economics appointed by the board of CEEC
12. **The panel:** will adjudicate on what in their opinion are the most innovative papers. There will be no appeal from the panel's decision, criteria will be issued to applicants on receipt of application. All accepted papers will receive acknowledgement.
13. **Award:** three candidates adjudged to have submitted the best papers will be invited to the next CEEC meeting in early May 2011 in Malta to present their work. The author of the best paper will receive award of 1000 EUR. The winner and the two runners up will receive accreditation from the CEEC.
