Seminar CEEC 'Housing in Europe!'

In the major cities all over Europe a new shortage of affordable housing has evolved. New-construction seems to be so expensive that it does not solve this problem for middle class citizens. In an international cost comparison research commissioned by the Irish government, Mulcahy McDonagh & Partners (MMP), together with several CEEC-members, assessed differences and similarities in the costs of the provision of housing in several countries. Can the outcome of this research give us a clue for the solution of this shortage of affordable housing? In order to provide sustainable housing in our cities, we should not only look at new-construction, but rather consider the state of the existing housing stock. What role can obsolete tenements or outdated offices play with regard to the shortage of affordable housing? What are the effects of sustainable renovation measures on housing costs?
